1	Blessed are the poor in spirit		A person who is "poor in spirit" recognizes that they need God. A person who depends on God everyday truly lives with God as their King.
2	Blessed are those who mourn		God has a special concern for those who feel sad and lonely. God also comforts us when we feel lost or are struggling with our personal failings.
3	Blessed are the meek		The word "meek" in the New Testament Greek language is "praus." It can describe a soothing medicine, a gentle breeze, or a strong domesticated animal. All are great powers under control.
4	Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness		Humans hunger for more than just food. When we work for justice and goodness, God fills our heart. When we don't do right, we feel empty.
5	Blessed are the merciful		Mercy is compassion in action. Merciful people help others because they know how good God has been to them. Merciful people are unselfish.
6	Blessed are the pure in heart		Want to "see" God? You must have a pure heart. How do you get a pure heart? Read Psalm 119: 9-16.
7	Blessed are the peacemakers		"Shalom" is the Hebrew word for peace. It means "restored," "made whole again." Peacemakers don't just quiet things down, they bring healing.
8	Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake		Persecution means "to be put down." There are people in this world who will persecute you for doing and saying what is right. Jesus promises a reward for being courageously good.
